


[Hyper-V] Activer Hyper-V

En ligne de commande :

1. Ouvrez une session PowerShell ou CMD en tant qu'administrateur.
2. Tapez la commande suivante :

```
DISM /Online /Enable-Feature /All /FeatureName:Microsoft-Hyper-V
```
